The candidate should be able to demonstrate a commitment to the promotion and reinforcement of the IFCC, its goals and its image. The candidate must:

- have a good knowledge of the mission and function of the IFCC
- possess fluent spoken and written English language skills
- have a broad experience of scientific and internet-based editing
- be proficient with information and communication technologies and social media
- be able to monitor technical progress in the fields of activity

The amount of work is equivalent to 1-3 days per month. The C-IDC meets once each year, mainly on occasion of the IFCC Congress, and has regular conference calls.

Applications must include:

- a proposal statement from the candidate for one of the positions.
- a short CV (max 2 pages), describing the professional and/or academic career, particularly highlighting the issues which could be important for the selection.
- letter of support from his or her National Society/Corporate member. The nominating member must be a current and fully paid member of IFCC.

Appointment for this position will be for one 3-year term of office, which is renewable for one additional 3-year term.
