- Letter of motivation from the candidate describing why they would like to work with the TF-E.
- Academic scholarship in ethics and Laboratory Medicine such as manuscript writing and publication, critical literature review and presentations are preferred.
- Curriculum Vitae of the nominee (including the email address describing the professional and/or academic career (including a list of publications), particularly highlighting ethics experience which could be important for the selection.
